This training program is designed to increase understanding of the different Evidence-Based Practices (EBPs) that can be immediately applied to address challenging behaviors in the classroom setting. We encourage both teams and individuals to participate in this training. Please bring a case study/student scenario to discuss as time will be provided within the training to apply learned principles to individual cases.

## **OUTCOMES:** Participants will:

- Learn strategies to reduce students' frustration level in the classroom
- > Learn to systematically address challenging behaviors and develop appropriate replacement behaviors
- Understand the four functions of behavior
- Learn positive behavior support procedures
- Learn best practices for documentation and data collection
- Learn to increase student compliance using effective reinforcement systems
- Apply strategies to individual case studies
