The English Learner Symposium is designed to provide educators with information and resources related to supporting assets-oriented and needs-responsive schools. The symposium content will focus on the implementation of the principles of the English Learner Roadmap, innovative and excellent practices for supporting English learners from local practitioners, and cultural responsiveness in order to help English learners achieve their highest potential.



Dr. Sharroky Hollie is a national expert on cultural responsiveness. Dr. Hollie has authored several texts and journal articles. Most recently, he wrote "Strategies for Culturally and Linguistically Responsive Teaching and Learning" (2015) and contributed a chapter in the *Oxford Handbook of African American Language* (2015). Dr. Hollie's first book, *Culturally and Linguistically Responsive Teaching and Learning: Classroom Practices for Student Success* was published in 2011, followed soon thereafter by *The Will to Lead, The Skill To Teach* co-written with Dr. Anthony Muhammad.



Dr. Laurie Olsen has spent the last five decades researching, writing, advocating, and providing leadership, development, and technical assistance for educational equity with an emphasis on immigrant and English learner education, language access, and rights. She researched and authored "Reparable Harm", a report highlighting the urgent need to address the language and academic needs of long term English learners. Dr. Olsen is also a co-author of "California's English Learner Roadmap", a policy with information and resources to assist LEAs to engage in continuous improvement and to advance outcomes for English learners, their families and communities.

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
