



Trauma-Informed Care Training

This two-day workshop, presented by Gabriella Grant, California Center of Excellence for Trauma Informed Care, will offer two days of trauma-informed insight and education.

Day One:

Foundations of trauma-informed services within public education. Attendees will explore the connection between trauma and educational success as well as the foundational concepts involved in being trauma-informed. The science of trauma including the vagus nerve will be discussed. Safety and its elements will be defined and applied in scenarios. Specific issues facing schools, students and staff. Skills, tools and ideas will be provided.

Day Two

Applying the neuro-sequential model of therapeutics (Perry) to didactics, lesson planning, school rules and interpreting the Ed Code into school policy effectively. This training is essential for teachers, administrators and support personal to see how to incorporate trauma-informed concepts into actual instruction and campus policy in order to reduce unsafe behaviors and increase a mutual sense of safety for students and staff.

All participants should plan on attending both days of this training.
