Description:

This interactive, in-person training introduces early childhood educators to the Desired Results Developmental Profile (DRDP) 2025, California's formative assessment instrument designed to document children's learning, development, and progress. Participants will gain an overview of the purpose, structure, and key features of the updated DRDP 2025, including developmental domains, measures, and rating levels. Through discussion, guided practice, and real-world examples, participants will explore how ongoing observation and documentation inform accurate ratings and support responsive, individualized teaching. This session is ideal for educators who are new to the DRDP or are transitioning to the 2025 version.

Outcomes:

Participants will be able to:

- Explain the purpose of the Desired Results Developmental Profile (DRDP) 2025 and its role in California's Desired Results System.
- Describe the organization and components of the DRDP 2025, including domains, measures, developmental levels, and rating procedures.
- Identify effective observation and documentation practices that support accurate and reliable assessment.
- Apply the DRDP 2025 rating process using evidence from child observations and documentation.
- Recognize how DRDP data can be used to inform individualized instruction, family partnerships, and continuous program improvement.
- Locate resources and support for continued implementation of the DRDP 2025 in early learning settings.
